Before we close up the walls, it's time to take a guided walkthrough and see what's behind them.

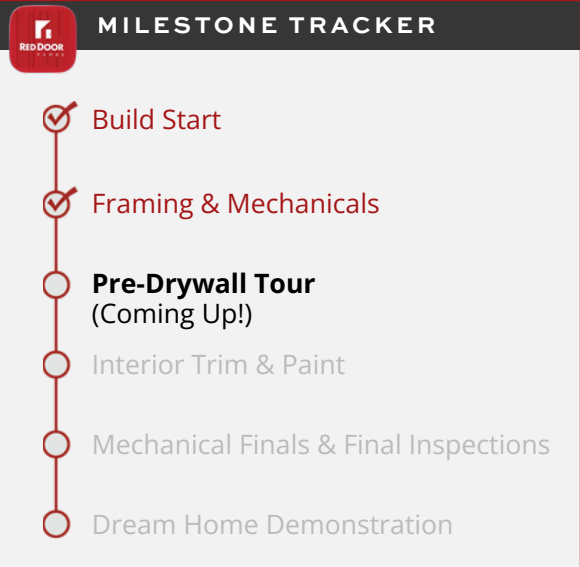
Next Step: PRE-DRYWALL TOUR
